Attorney Diller stated the purpose of this hearing is to accept public comment on the Appropriation Ordinance for fiscal year 2015-2016. This ordinance is passed by the Board and acts as the Village's authority to spend money. It's part one of a two-step process; the second part being the levy ordinance which is passed in the fall.

The Appropriation Ordinance was circulated at the last meeting and has been on file for review in the Clerk's office. Under Illinois law, the Village is required to have a public hearing. The proposed ordinance calls for a grand total appropriation of \$6,955,640, which is the maximum amount by law that the Village could spend.
