The Intergovernmental Agreement between Thornton and School District 154 for crossing guards was approved. Lastly, there was discussion regarding the Public Works vehicle that was recently purchased. The Board is discussing possibly turning that vehicle over to the Police Department and purchasing a truck for Public Works.

Commissioner Carlson stated he attended the March 2 Board meeting wherein the Board approved repairing the Village Clock at a cost of \$5,800, which can be taken out of Downtown TIF funds. There was also Board discussion regarding fixing the generator behind the Village Hall. Renewing the Tri-State Disposal contract was discussed, but there was no vote taken yet. The Soltice Family; the Mitigation Disaster Plan; and a new water meter reading device were discussed. The contract with Municipal Collections was approved; and Russ Oberman was appointed Superintendent of Public Works.

Commissioner Carlson remarked there was a Proclamation presented to John Levon for all his hard work and dedication to the Village of Thornton.
